The Council of Asian Pacific Americans (CAPA) in collaboration with other Asian Pacific Associations across Michigan will host a statewide leadership conference on Saturday, December 3, 2011, focusing on building bridges and fostering growth within the Asian Pacific American community and other organizations with the goal of bringing about positive social and economic change. The Ninth annual Asian Pacific American Leadership Summit will be held from 9:00am – 3:00pm at the Comerica Operations Center - 39200 W. Six Mile Rd., Livonia, MI48152.

The 2011 Leadership Summit will provide a forum for leaders of Asian American organizations and leaders in the community and government to share and celebrate the accomplishments of various organizations. Additionally, it will identify means to contribute to the economic revitalization of Michigan and make the State an attractive place for Asian Americans to live.
